## SUMMARY

Quail is offered in the form of a 'sailaway' with the back cabin being fitted by Rex Wain and a Gardner 3LW, which was rebuilt by Danny Williamson being housed in the engine room. The main accommodation has been sprayfoamed and is awaiting a fit out.

The superstructure is finished in a holding primer and the hull was built with shotblast and primed plate, which has been coated with 2-pack epoxy black.

This a truly unique boat, which has been built to the highest quality and must be viewed to be fully appreciated.

## CABIN 28FT 5IN

The cabin has been sprayfoamed, ballasted and had floors fitted. The plan at the back of the brochure shows where the cabin apertures are placed to enable workings out of any potential layout designs.
